The first committee chosen to draft the bylaws included: Dan Burke, John Deckard, Tony Ko, Andrew Sanders, Betty Schabacker, Carl Sundberg, and John Vanco.

Now in its 50th year, the NPAA organizes several annual exhibits for its 100+ members' participation, annually donates college scholarship monies to local graduating high-school seniors, and overall promotes the visual arts in the tri-county community.


