There is a 40" x 40" size limitation. Work must be framed, wired, labeled and ready to hang. Work with saw tooth hangers will not be accepted.

3-dimensional work should be limited in size as there is limited display area. Please contact me if you are entering a three-dimensional piece. We want to make sure we can accommodate you well.

All work must be original, clean and pose no hazard.

Work entered should be family friendly. The Exhibitions Committee reserves the right to decline submissions.

work. The NPAA will not be responsible for loss, damage, or theft of any work.






