
REFLECTIONS

Conditions and Instructions:

Work must be framed, wired, labeled and ready to hang. Work with saw tooth hangers will not be accepted. All work must be original, clean and pose no hazard.

Due to space we need to restrict the size of the pieces entered to no larger than

36" X 36""

Work must fit through standard doors; may be assembled once inside.
Three- D work is accepted. Pedestals are available.




